





12. That there are no criminal cases proceedings pending against the above officials before any investigating agency viz:(VOK Crime branch) or court of law and the genuineness of appointment has been ascertained / established in respect of the employee/s.
13. The DDO concerned will follow all codal formalities before making fixation or releasing the arrears of in-situ promotion.
14. The DDO concerned shall strictly adhere to the instructions envisaged in order to rule out any mistake.
